We will celebrate the Mass of Remembrance (a.k.a., Mass of Memories, Mass of All Souls) on Saturday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> at 3:30 p.m.. This special Catholic liturgy is to commemorate our loved ones who have passed.

## **How To Prepare?**

You should receive your All Souls' envelopes in your offertory envelope packet for the Mass of Remembrance. If you do not receive your offertory envelopes via mail, an All Soul's envelope may be obtained from the office.

## To Have Your Loved Ones Added- We Kindly Ask:

1. Please CLEARLY PRINT only the family's surname (last name) of your deceased loved ones and ONLY on the envelope (e.g., Deceased Members of the Roberts Family). Please understand, due to the growth of our parish & time constraints, we are not able to read each individual family member separately.

2. Envelopes are to be RETURNED in the lockbox on the office door or through weekend collections NO LATER than 12:00 p.m., OCTOBER 31st.

† Family's Surname (last name) MUST be LEGIBLE in order to be INCLUDED.

During the Mass of Remembrance, all the names will be read, and a family representative will light a candle and place it in the box in front of the Altar. Envelopes will remain on the Altar until the last day of November. Throughout the entire month of November, these names will be remembered in our prayers and as a community of believers.
